

2024/25 MFSC Volunteer Hour & Fundraising Responsibilities



The Midland Figure Skating Club (MFSC) needs the help of all of our member families to be a successful, vibrant organization. We offer many opportunities for various ages and skill levels to get involved. Working together is FUN!

To ensure the health of MFSC, all member families must volunteer / fundraise, as outlined below. Fundraising requirements must be met by April 30th, 2025 and volunteer requirements by May 30th, 2025.

Volunteer Responsibilities

- Volunteer hours are earned on an hourly basis (e.g. if you volunteer for an ice show and do two hours of work, you earn two hours of volunteer time)
- ***You are responsible for tracking your volunteer hours in your EntryEeze account***
- All volunteer hours must be completed by May 30, 2025. Accounts will be billed for the remaining hours after this date
- **You will be billed \$15 for each volunteer hour not completed**
- Note that US Figure Skating prohibits giving volunteer hours for fundraising activities benefiting an individual skater

1) Volunteer hours to be completed by May 30, 2025

- a. 20 hours per Junior / Adult member family
- b. 15 hours per Second Year member family
- c. 10 hours per First Year member family
- d. 10 hours per Associate member family
- e. 5 hours per Team Only member

2) Volunteer hours to be completed for EACH competition hosted by MFSC

- a. 2 hours per Junior / Adult member family
 - b. 2 hours per Second Year member family
 - c. 2 hours per First Year member family
 - d. 2 hours per Associate member family
- Skate Midland will be hosted on **November 9, 2024 – please add the date to your calendar!** Other competitions may be bid on by MFSC and would require an *additional* 2 volunteer hours per competition, per member family
 - Competitions are one of MFSC's main sources of income – without volunteers we cannot run a successful event. A positive experience for skaters, coaches, and judges is important to attract future competitions/events to our arena
 - Work the day of the competition or volunteer for tasks that need to be done prior to competition day (registration, program, official gifts, food preparation, etc.)

Earning Your Hours

Please check which of the following activities you feel you would be available to help with:

- Become SafeSport certified for 2024/25 – must be age 18+ (1 hour)
- Learn to Skate – on the ice or at the Learn to Skate information table (1/2 hour per class)
- Passing out flyers to preschools/businesses for MFSC events (1 hour per event)
- Cleaning the locker room (1 hour)
- Ice Monitor (1/2 hour per session)
- Loons Game Concession Worker (4 hours)
- Shows / Exhibitions (hours vary)
- Marketing (hours vary)
- Sponsorship committee – secure corporate sponsorships to support MFSC (hours vary)
- Hospitality – prepare/purchase food for various events (hours vary)
- Annual Meeting – planning and preparations for May meeting (hours vary)

Fundraising Responsibilities

- Fulfill your fundraising requirement through any combination of the activities listed below
- **Any difference between your amount raised and the \$100 requirement will be billed to your account after April 30, 2025**

1) Fundraise by April 30, 2025

- a. *\$100 per Junior / Adult member family*
- b. *\$100 per Second Year member family*
- c. *\$100 per First Year member family*
- d. *\$100 per Associate member family*

2) Fundraising Opportunities

- a. Major annual fundraiser (this year's major fundraising activity is TBD – stay tuned for more information)
- b. Smaller club fundraisers (mum sale, blood drive, jewelry sale, etc.)
- c. RaiseRight (earn while you shop)

Failure to complete your required volunteer hours / fundraising and/or pay related penalties will result in your membership being placed in “bad standing” with US Figure Skating and you will be unable to renew until your obligations are fulfilled.
